ATTACHMENT AND INTERNSHIP OPPORTUNITIES AT NATIONAL LAND COMMISSION

National Land Commission (NLC) is an independent constitutional Commission established and operationalized under Article 67 of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, the National Land Commission Act, 2012 and the National Land Policy, 2009 respectively.

In an endeavour to complement Governments efforts in creating opportunities for Kenyan youth to gain relevant experience and/or to expose them to work environment so as to increase their chances of employability, National Land Commission offers Attachments and Internships to relevant ongoing students and young graduates respectively. On one hand, Attachments targets students who are seeking attachment opportunities for purpose of academic requirement for completion of a course (Attachments for a maximum of 3 months). This must be backed up with evidence from an accredited institution of learning for either diploma or degree programs. On the other hand, Internship at the NLC targets recent graduates who have completed their studies and have graduated or awaiting graduation. This program is provided for a maximum period of six (6) months.

The Commission shall advertise for these opportunities vide various channels and the same shall be processed on quarterly basis. However, under exceptional circumstances, the Commission shall process applications outside this bracket because it is alive to the fact that some universities/colleges have different timings in terms of academic calendars. Notwithstanding the foregoing, NLC shall maintain a database of prospective Interns/Students for references as and when an opportunity arises.

In this view of the above, the Commission is delighted to advertise the following fourteen (14) and thirty two (32) Attachment and Internship vacancies respectively in various Directorates/ Departments with effect from 1st July, 2018.

2. Be unemployed Kenyan aged between 20 and 35 years

 2. Not retired or exited from formal employment
 3. Must have completed their training and graduated with documentary proof of qualification (Degree/Diploma Certificate or Transcripts)
3. Copy of the Intern/student's certificate of good conduct
4. Copy of the Intern/student's national identity card or passport
5. Two recent passport size photographs
6. Letter of introduction form the University indicating their field of study and the number of credits for the practical attachment (Students on Attachment)
7. Proof of insurance cover
